Dear Ms Lui,

Thank you for your reply dated 2 July, 2021.

We are pleased to hear that the LCSD supports the position that NSAs, including the HKIHA, are “required to conduct their internal business in accordance with their Articles of Association (AoA) in an open, fair and transparent manner”. However, as we write in our letter dated 2 June 2021, the HKIHA does not adhere to this policy. This is evident from the questions raised in our original letter about the so-called “Junior National Team” and Mr. Kan’s Gold Club.

We also support LCSD’s position that NSAs, including the HKIHA, “make publicly available on their website information regarding their governance structure and operations, including their AoA”. While we are pleased to hear that the HKIHA is reviewing its AoA to enhance governance, the current website as of the writing of this letter fails to include any information with respect to: board nominations, attendance of individuals at board meetings, and policies for inclusion and diversity. We would encourage the HKIHA to present its governance on its website.

The China Hockey Group received a letter from Mr. Mike Kan, 2018-2022 Chairman of the HKIHA, dated 17 June, 2021. Mr. Kan has regrettably misunderstood our concerns and questions. We wish to again state clearly and unequivocally that I do not want to be the President of the HKIHA nor do I wish for the CHG to be the sole ice hockey organization in Hong Kong.

We are simply calling for the HKIHA to hold an open election in 2022 and that the HKIHA actually develop and execute policies and programs to develop ice hockey in Hong Kong. The success of these programs is ultimately reflected in the ranking of the Hong Kong’s
